You will design and deliver inclusive, engaging, and industry-aligned curriculum that is responsive to the diverse needs and lived experiences of each learner. In this role, you will foster a safe, welcoming, and supportive learning environment that encourages academic achievement, personal growth, and long-term success.

#### **KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Develop curriculum and implement engaging lesson plans that align with educational and industry standards, while remaining sensitive to the needs of vulnerable populations.
- Create a supportive, inclusive classroom atmosphere that fosters student engagement and promotes a positive learning environment.
- Provide individualized academic support and mentorship to students to enhance their learning experience.
- Collaborate with colleagues and support staff to enhance program effectiveness and student outcomes.
- Participate in ongoing professional development to remain informed of best practices in trauma-informed education and learner-centered approaches.
- Communicate regularly with students regarding their performance, progress, and classroom activities to support their academic development.
- Ensure a safe, respectful, and welcoming classroom environment that reflects EFry's values of dignity, equity, and empowerment.
- Conduct regular assessments and maintain documentation to track student progress, identify learning needs, and support continuous improvement.

- Experience working effectively with vulnerable populations, demonstrating empathy, patience, and cultural sensitivity
- Ability to provide individualized academic support and mentorship
- Strong organizational and classroom management skills
