We are recruiting for a Part Time, Cook for our Ellendale & Cradle Programs. Located in Surrey, Ellendale and Cradle workers support women with substance use issues to live in a communal full-time live-in structured stabilization and transitional living residence in Surrey. A planned meal service offers three meals (breakfast, lunch, and dinner) daily. The Cook will oversee the weekend operation of the kitchen in a residential facility, including all aspects of planning, receiving, storage, preparation, and service of food.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Responsible for general food preparation and cooking meals.
- Ensures a high level of quality, cleanliness, and safety in all food preparation in adherence to Environmental Health and Community Care Facilities Licensing Regulations.
- Ensures Food Safe standards are followed at all times.
- Follow dietitian approved meal plans and modify meals to meet individual dietary requirements.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Completion of grade 12 plus one (1) year related experience.
- Graduation from a 12-month recognized cooking program.
- Experience working in a licensed facility would be an asset.
- Excellent communication skills both written and verbal.
- Ability to lift up to 30 lbs.

- Standard First Aid with CPR-C, an asset.
- Evidence of COVID-19 vaccination status.
