The Elizabeth Fry Society of Greater Vancouver (EFry) is a charitable organization that supports women, girls, and children at risk, involved in or affected by the justice system. Our programs work to break the cycle of poverty, addiction, mental illness, homelessness, and crime.

We are recruiting for a casual, Cook for our IRT Program. Located in Chilliwack, the Rosedale Intensive Treatment program provides live-in services for women with moderate to severe substance misuse. Women participate in up to 5 months of structured relapseprevention and counselling whereby they can plan for their long-term needs and participate in psychoeducational groups, receive clinical counselling, and develop as needed relationships with community services. The program operates on an awake around the clock basis providing women withindividualized case management planning and coordination to manage substance use dependence, and the transition from live-in services and supports. The embedded Clinical Counsellor provides individualand group, short-term, counselling support to clients.

## **KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Responsible for general food preparation and cooking meals.
- Ensures a high level of quality, cleanliness, and safety in all food preparation in adherence to Environmental Health and Community Care Facilities Licensing Regulations.
- Ensures Food Safe standards are followed at all times.
- Follow dietitian approved meal plans and modify meals to meet individual dietary requirements.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Completion of grade 12 plus one (1) year related experience.
- Graduation from a 12-month recognized cooking program.
- Experience working in a licensed facility would be an asset.
- Excellent communication skills both written and verbal.
- Ability to lift up to 30 lbs.

- Standard First Aid with CPR-C, an asset.
- Evidence of COVID-19 vaccination status.
