The Elizabeth Fry Society of Greater Vancouver (EFry) is a charitable organization that supports women, girls, and children at risk, involved in or affected by the justice system. Our programs work to break the cycle of poverty, addiction, mental illness, homelessness, and crime.

We are recruiting a Temporary Part-Time Facilitator for Growing Great Kids Program, located in Surrey. This temporary position for one year is responsible for receiving the training and facilitation of the Curriculum Growing Great Kids, which includes both individual and group sessions for families within our EFry programs, the community and at Alouette Correctional Centre for Women. The primary objective is to create and sustain an environment in which parents actively participate in their child's developmental activities, thereby fostering, supporting, and enhancing parent-child relationships.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- After training, will facilitate The Growing Great Kids Program with families in our EFry programs, in the community and at Alouette Correctional Centre for Women
- Provides support to parents in developing or enhancing secure attachments and parental empathy in parents when ACE's might be prevalent in their own childhoods
- Facilitates referrals to community resources for parents and children when necessary
- Provides comprehensive guidance to parents concerning their child's developmental activities by sharing solution-focused skill building strategies to enhance their parenting skills
- Submit information to monthly, quarterly and annual reports as required by Supervisor
- Advertises or promotes the Growing Great Kids program around communities
- Maintains detailed case management records that document each client's developmental progress while enrolled in the program using data recording system Nucleus
- Procures necessary supplies for the Growing Great Kids program
- Executes other related duties as required

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be trained in Post-secondary education and early child education, social or human services, or equivalent experience
- Familiarity, knowledge and skill in, family systems and youth/family/community issues
- Must possess a valid Class 5 Driver's license, or be in the process of obtaining one
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills

- Self-directed, with an ability to work independently and as an effective member
- Demonstrated ability to multi-task and adapt to changing workloads
- Demonstrated ability in assessment and crisis intervention skills, and individual, family and group counselling skills
- The ability to function independently and manage a significant workload is an ongoing expectation of this position
